Mental Health Practitioner Travel Reimbursement (Medicaid)

Effective January 1, 2022, Molina Healthcare of Washington has been allotted a pool of funds by the Health Care Authority for travel reimbursement related to assessments for mental health diagnosis for infants and young children.

Eligibility Criteria

Medicaid providers must be travelling for the purpose of:

- Conducting mental health assessments for a child under 6 years of age in the child/family's home or in a community setting

Providers are eligible for reimbursement for up to 5 sessions for mental health assessments, if necessary.

Claims and Reimbursement Requirements

Providers must complete:

- Molina's A-19
- W9
- Supplier Profile Form

Molina's A-19 and Supplier Profile Form can be found at:

<https://www.molinahealthcare.com/providers/wa/medicaid/forms/fuf.aspx>. Forms and invoices must be submitted to **WA_Finance_IMC@molinahealthcare.com**. Claims must be submitted prior to invoice submission. Molina will process and reimburse providers within 10 business days of submission.

Invoices will not be paid without an adjudicated claim and invoices must be submitted no later than 60 days from the supporting claim.

Funds for travel reimbursement are available until the pool of money has been depleted. Please note that services provided to Wraparound Intensive Services (WISe) members are not eligible for provider travel reimbursement.
